Dual Career Advice of ETH Zurich Dual Career Support

ETH Zurich strives at hiring outstanding professors from all over the world. Not only experience but also research shows that people with a high education often have partners with an equally high education who put emphasis on their career – this particularly applies to women! Whereas in the past, universities tended to hire mostly men as professors and whereas their wives back then agreed to follow their husbands and to give up their own careers for the sake of his, this changed completely in more recent years. Hiring an outstanding professor today means working also with his or her partner to allow them a smooth continuation of their career despite an international move. ETH Zurich is strongly committed to dual career couples whatever the background and career of the partner.

Our aim

We want that partners are not forced to end or considerably slow down their professional careers after the international move, but continue it according to their track record and plans.

Since our focus is on the successful hiring of professors, every professional commitment a partner had is a career we take seriously and support. We provide assistance to:

- Dual career couples and support the partner in continuing his or her scientific career at a Swiss university or university of applied sciences
- Partners who aim at continuing their careers in a Swiss or international corporate company
- Partners who wish to relaunch their careers after a career break due to parenthood
- Partners who wish to change their careers and follow continuing education

Dual Career Couples

Scientists partner with scientists, couples form at work and during the education, this applies also to the professors ETH Zurich hires. ETH Zurich is responsive to dual career couples and aims at enabling both partners to continue their careers. We do this by contacting professors at ETH Zurich and outside who work in the same field as the second hire and introduce the partner to the relevant community. This allows the second hire to present his/her research and palmaris, develop projects that can be carried out and link to ongoing projects. Since (outside) funding might not be available at the very beginning, the president of ETH Zurich can co-finance a temporary position for a second hire for an initial period.

Employment and careers

The strategies for finding a job in industry and corporate companies are different in each country. There are many explicit and implicit aspects which need to be considered when searching for a job in Switzerland and we help you with these. We assist in revising CVs and cover letters to suit the Swiss job market and guide you through a typical Swiss application process (*see application guide of the ETH Zurich Career Center). We further organise a variety of workshops aimed at helping newcomers understand the way in which recruitment works, how a convincing LinkedIn-profile is created and how a new network can be created and tapped into. All partners also have access to the International Dual Career Network Zurich-Zug-Schaffhausen (www.idcn.info) which is an excellent introduction to the major employers in the Greater Zurich Area.
